Guided inquiry has the benefits of traditional instruction: it is both cost efficient and goal oriented This method also has benefits of discovery learning: students experience and explore learning in a collaborative manner Additionally, and notably, guided inquiry method is proven successful both in terms of academic and cognitive learning

Comparing Guided Discovery and Exposition-with-Interaction ...

Guided discovery (GD) method of teaching biology is recommended in secondary schools but many teachers use exposition-with-interaction (EI) GD requires process skills such as experiment design, observation and manipulation of variables to discover answers; whereas EI uses lecturing, asking questions and giving notes to learners to memorize
